VENDOR AGREEMENT FORM

The 44th Annual Winter Carnival will be held January 30-February 8, 2009 in McCall, Idaho. The vendor set-up area will be open to vendors for set-up on Friday, January 30th from 11:00am through 5:00pm. The festivities will begin at 6:00pm on Friday and will continue until approximately 9:00pm. Vendors should not shut down their booths until after 8:30 pm. On Saturday, January 31st the Mardi Gras Grand Parade will begin at Noon with festivities continuing until approximately 9:00pm. Again vendors should not close their booth(s) until after 8:30pm.

Vendor is responsible for payment for any and all applicable sales tax. Idaho State Sales Tax Forms will be available at check-in.

Vendor Check-in is from 11:00am to 2:00pm on Friday, January 30th – **All vendors must be in place by 2:00pm on opening day so electricians can complete their work, even if you do not need electricity.**

Vendors are NOT granted an exclusive right to exhibit their products or services in this event and none is implied verbally.

It is recommended that the exhibitors protect themselves fully with regard to any property loss or damage as a result of this exhibit as the McCall Chamber of Commerce assumes no responsibility.

The McCall Chamber of Commerce, its officers, agents, employees and other representatives shall not be held liable for, and they are hereby released from liability for, any damage, loss, harm or injury to the person or property of the vendor or any of its officers, agents, employees, or other representatives, resulting from theft, fire, water, weather, accident or other cause.
