Rules, Instructions, and Prizes 2009 Local Snow Sculpture Contest Theme "Fantasy In Ice"

Rules

1. Sculpture must be completely ice or snow clad.
2. Supporting Structure (Armature) - Lathe, Wire, Rebar and PVC pipe only.
NO plywood, sheet lumber, or cardboard.
3. Judging - Based on:

A. Visual Impact	10 points	D. Detail	10 points
B. Artistic Merit	10 points	E. Difficulty	10 points
C. Originality	10 points	F. Theme Presentation	10 points
TOTAL POSSIBLE		60 points	

Instructions

1. ORDERING SNOW - Please call the city, Dept of Public Works (634-5580) between 8:00 a.m. and 4:30 p.m., and they will deliver snow to your construction site on an "unscheduled" basis. *This means snow delivery is not their top priority.*

* Please order your snow 24-48 hours before it is needed and the city will make every effort to meet your request, **BUT NO GUARANTEES!**

* Maximum of 3 loads per delivery.

* They **will not** fill frames, dump on sidewalk or drive upon the sidewalk.

* They will dump snow next to sculpture for your use. Please make sure to mark the delivery location well.

* Dept of Public Works will do their best to provide clean snow but not guaranteed.

* Dept of Public Works **will not** take snow back if you decide its too much.

2. JUDGING - Judging begins at 8:00 a.m. Friday 30th!! The judges will not wait until you complete your sculpture and the sculptures are randomly judged, not in any particular order.

3. ANNOUNCEMENT OF CONTEST WINNERS - Winners of the contest will be announced at Opening Ceremonies in downtown McCall, Friday January 30th beginning at 6:30 p.m. PLEASE PLAN TO HAVE YOUR ENTIRE TEAM ATTEND. ALL WINNING TEAMS WILL BE PUBLICLY RECOGNIZED.
